This Office interposes no objection to the above-mentioned activity provided that the participation of DepEd Personnel is voluntary in nature and no government funds shall be utilized.

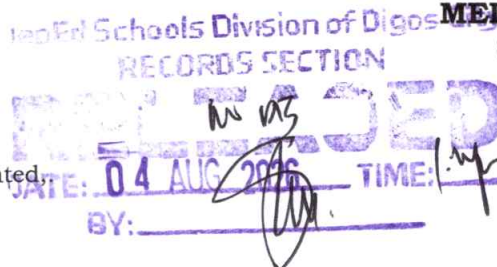

Subject: **7th ONE MINDANAO SCOUT JAMBOREE**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Davao del Sur-Occidental Council is organizing a contingent to the **7th One Mindanao Scout Jamboree** on **September 02-06, 2026** at BSP Camp Obedencia in the **Municipality of Lala, Province of Lanao del Norte**, with the theme: "Uniting a Stronger Scouting in Mindanao."
2. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVE.** The Jamboree aims to provide opportunities for Scouts to practice and enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potential, and discover and act upon their strengths through challenging, adventurous and experimental learning activities.
3. **QUALIFICATIONS.** The following are the qualifications for participation.
 - 3.1. A Scout is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, must have parental consent and must be:
 - Registered as a Boy Scout or Senior Scout with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - 12 years old and above but not over 18 years old;
 - Fully equipped with camping gears;
 - Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician
 - 3.2. Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role and must be:
 - Registered as an Adult Leader with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - Trained as a Unit Leader, and preferable a BTC graduate;
 - Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
 - Fully Equipped with camping gears;
4. **REGISTRATION FEE.** A registration fee of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (**₱1,000.00**) shall be collected from each participant. The registration fee must be paid to the council on or before **July 30, 2026, Thursday**.
5. **TRANSPORTATION.** All participating delegates shall provide their own transportation to and from the Jamboree Site and are advised to submit their Itinerary to the Local Council for record and reference purposes. Furthermore, all participants are advised to report at the Jamboree Site not later than **02 September 2026** and will only be cleared to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremonies.
6. **FOOD PROVISION.** All participants must provide for their own food and other basic necessities that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the event. Wet and dry markets will be made available near the Camp Site.

7. **WHAT TO BRING.** Participants are REQUIRED to bring the following camping items, to wit:
- Type "A" Scout Uniform with black leather shoes;
 - Sportswear and personal gears/beddings/tents;
 - Eating utensils and toiletries;
 - Medicine/First Aid Kit;
 - Duly filled-up application form with parental consent and medical certificate.
8. Corresponding compensatory overtime and/or service credits shall be granted to all serving and accompanying Adult Leaders as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
