Subject: **CONDUCT OF THE CHIEF GIRL SCOUT MEDAL SCHEME ORIENTATION
2026 AND PATROL LEADERS CAMP PERMIT COURSE TRAINING**

Date: August 5, 2026

In reference to the GSP Council Circular No. 58, Series of 2026, dated July 18, 2026, this Office informs all concerned of the conduct of the **Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme Orientation 2026 and Patrol Leaders Camp Permit Course Training** on **August 21-23, 2026 at the GSP Almendras Camp, Upper Matti, Digos City.**

The activity is part of the continuing leadership development program of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP), which aims to strengthen the leadership competencies, community involvement, and outdoor skills of Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts.

The Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme Orientation will be participated in by Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts who are interested in pursuing the Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme, the highest award for Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts. The orientation shall prepare participants for the implementation of their one-year community service project and other requirements leading to the attainment of the Chief Girl Scout Medal.

Meanwhile, the Patrol Leaders Camp Permit Course Training will cater to Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts who wish to enhance their leadership and outdoor camping skills. The training will cover basic camping knowledge and practical outdoor skills, including basic knots, tent pitching, campsite management, fire building, cooking, first aid, and other essential scouting competencies required for the Patrol Leaders Camp Permit.

School GSP Coordinators are requested to facilitate the registration and confirmation of participants on or before August 20, 2026, to allow the organizers to prepare the necessary meals, training materials, manuals, badges, certificates, and other logistical requirements.

A registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) per participant shall be collected by the organizers to cover meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner on August 22, 2026, and breakfast on August 23, 2026), training and program materials, Chief Girl Scout Medal Manual, badges, certificates, activity materials, and other operational and administrative expenses.

Participants shall bring their personal camping and training requirements, including a bedroll or sleeping bag, scout tent, official Girl Scout uniform, outdoor uniform (GSP T-shirt



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and Bermuda shorts), eating utensils (mess kit), personal hygiene kit, personal medicines, sleeping garments, packed lunch and dinner for August 21, 2026, flashlight with extra batteries, notebook and ballpen, and a refillable water bottle.

The prescribed attire during the activity shall be as follows:

Opening and Closing Ceremonies: Official Girl Scout Uniform

Training Sessions: Comfortable attire

Workshop Presentations and Outdoor Activities: Outdoor Uniform (GSP T-shirt and Bermuda shorts)

Service Credits shall be granted to teacher-participants and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) to non-teaching personnel who will render services during the activity, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024.

All concerned school heads and GSP Coordinators are enjoined to provide the necessary support and assistance to ensure the successful participation of qualified delegates in this leadership development activity.

2. Patrol Leaders Camp Permit Course Training

Participants: Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts who wish to enhance their leadership and outdoor camping skills. The training will cover basic camping knowledge and practical outdoor skills, including basic knots, tent pitching, campsite management, fire building, cooking, first aid, and other essential scouting competencies required for the Patrol Leaders Camp Permit.

Participants are requested to bring the following:

- Bedroll or sleeping bag
- Scout tent
- Official Girl Scout Uniform
- Outdoor Uniform (GSP T-shirt and Bermuda shorts)
- Eating utensils (mess kit)
- Personal hygiene kit
- Personal medicines
- Sleeping garments
- Packed lunch and dinner for August 21, 2026
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Notebook and ballpen
- Refillable water bottle

Registration Fee

A registration fee of **Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00)** per participant shall be collected to cover the following:

- Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner on **August 22, 2026**, and Breakfast on **August 23, 2026**)
- Training and program materials
- Chief Girl Scout Medal Manual
- Badges
- Certificates

- Activity materials – for the Patrol leaders like bamboos and others

Furthermore, **Service Credits** shall be granted to teacher-participants, while **Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC)** shall be granted to participating non-teaching personnel, subject to the existing rules and regulations of the Department of Education (DepEd).

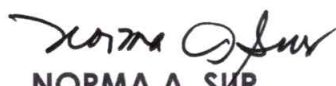
