This refers to the recently issued **DepEd Memorandum No. 048, s. 2026**, titled *Allocation and Release of the School Innovation and Improvement Fund to Non-Implementing Unit Public Schools to Strengthen Decentralization Practices in the Department of Education for Fiscal Year 2026*. This Memorandum outlines the guidelines and implementation arrangements for the utilization of the SIIF in support of sustained and expanded school-level interventions addressing learning gaps in literacy and numeracy. It likewise aims to strengthen decentralization at the school level by providing schools with greater fiscal autonomy and flexibility in planning, managing, and implementing responsive interventions based on their specific needs and priorities.

Building on the previous year of implementation, the FY 2026 rollout reinforces the Department's commitment to sustain and scale up effective strategies, expand program reach to more schools, and further improve learner outcomes. With the FY 2026 allocation, schools are expected to demonstrate greater efficiency and accountability in the use of supplemental funds for innovation and improvement initiatives.

All are expected to complete the Online Attendance form in accordance with administrative protocols for conducting official activities.
