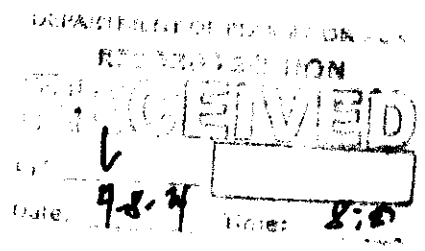


A regular registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000) for teachers and Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000) for students shall be charged to cover workshop expenses including workshop materials, supplies and kits, honoraria for speakers, resource persons, staff, performing groups, tickets to evening shows and other incidental expenses.

Participants shall take care of their own transportation, accommodations and meals. Assistance shall be provided in the arrangements for accommodation on a first come, first serve basis, in selected schools, dormitories, hotels and other lodging areas in the city especially for participants coming from other regions.

STEP 1

Registrant shall pay the amount of

and **Php 4,850 for Regular Attendee** and
Php 3,850 for Student Starting **June 1** till the **20th of June, 2024**
(excluding the convenience fee) to PFDS bank account only.
(instructions in using gcash or paymaya shall be provided).



STEP 2



Registrant shall fill out the registration form through the **google link** to be provided by the organization. He/she shall **attach the picture/soft copy** of the **screenshot of online payment** and his/her **picture to be used in his/her workshop ID**. Preferably in white or solid background. ****for student registrants, they shall also attach their valid undergraduate student ID.**

STEP 3

The **Finance Officer of the PFDS** shall validate the registration and confirm thru the shared database. You will receive a **confirmation email** once your registration is confirmed.
