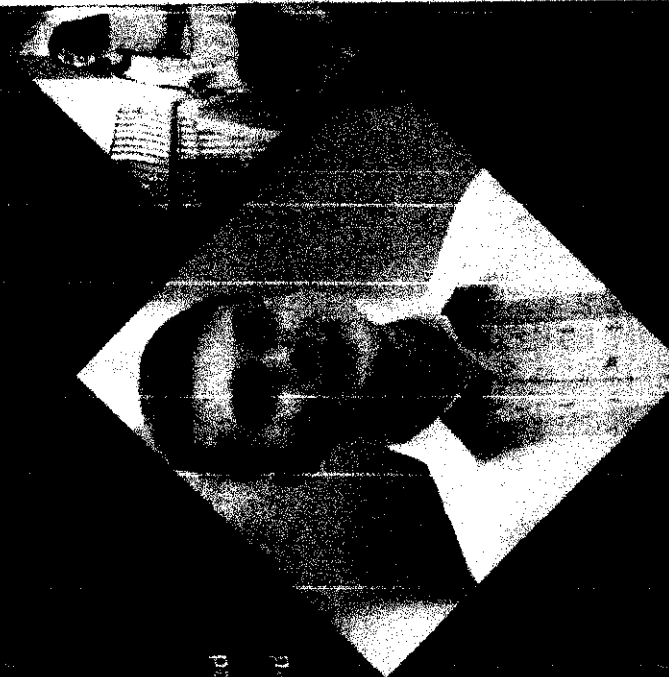

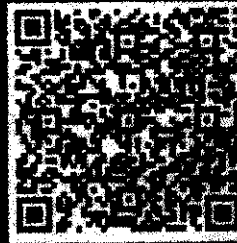

Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Must have at least one (1) year of teaching experience in either a public or private school with the intent to teach as a K-12 public school STEM teacher, or in the tertiary level as a STEM professor at any STEM-related school in state (for multi-state K-12 teaching careers, will be on an annual basis, not biennial basis) within a previous academic year according to the Department of Education's (NJDOE) previous educational opportunities in STEM (generative learning system, tech, certification, or skills) education
- ✓ Must have a general weighted average of at least 2.0 or its equivalent from the previous academic year
- ✓ Must be enrolled in a Teacher Education Institution (TEI) within or above the national average LFT performance
- ✓ Exemplify good moral character and engage in active participation and involvement in extra-curricular activities
- ✓ In need of financial assistance

Scholarship Benefits

- ✓ Annual financial support: Php 45,000 for scholars enrolled in State Universities and Php 65,000 for scholar enrolled in Private Universities
- ✓ Access to different scholar development programs (Leadership development, upskilling, subject content mastery, and support from a community of educators)

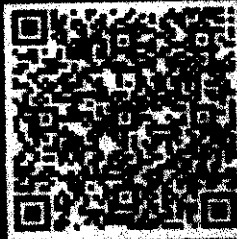

- ✓ In need of financial assistance.
