Should the Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (ASDS), CID Chief Education Supervisors, Education Program Supervisors (EPS), Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS), School Heads, School Paper Advisers/Teachers intend to attend as support to their contestants, their attendance shall be regarded as official business. However, they shall arrange their travel, meals, board and lodging for the duration of their stay.

Coaches who will participate in the NSPC shall be granted service credits for the services rendered on Saturday pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s.2003. The Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to personnel based on CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 for the services rendered during Saturday and Sunday.

Incidental and travel allowance of coaches and official delegates shall be charged against School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) /local/regional/Special Education Fund/school journalism fund, whichever is applicable. However, travel expenses of student contestants will be subsidized by CO and will be charged against the Development and Promotion of Campus Journalism (DPCJ) funds downloaded to each division. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
